Who are you as an artist? ARTISTIC VOICE

300 Words, 4 points

Alexa Rose wants to support artists who have something to say and are saying it in a compelling and thought-provoking manner. This should be reflected in your work samples, as well as HOW you describe your intention behind your work. Why do you make art? What is this art saying to the world around you?

Impact Statement CREATIVE IMPACT

300 Words, 6 points

This is the core of what Alexa Rose is about. While strong work samples are important, we are most interested in the creative impact of a potential grant given. Think of this in terms of GROWTH, CHALLENGE, and LONG-TERM PAYOFF. How would you grow, explore, or discover by receiving funding? How will this opportunity push, challenge, or advance your artistic career? This should be linked to the SPECIFICITY of your request. For example, if you wanted to travel to attend a workshop, why this workshop? Why this location?

QUALITY OF WORK

3 points

Your work samples should demonstrate your level of craftsmanship, technique and/or potential. Do your work samples demonstrate a strong understanding of, or skill within, your medium? Do your work samples demonstrate average to above-average talent, technical skill, or potential? Do your work samples demonstrate a professional, high-caliber skillset?

URGENCY

2 points

Does your application demonstrate a sense of urgency? WHY should this opportunity be acted upon now?

Are you a member of a Boise Valley tribe? If yes, please describe your tribal affiliation.

Have you received an ARF grant in the past? If yes, please indicate which year(s) you received an Alexa Rose grant, with a brief description of what the grant was used for.

Biography

Your bio should highlight the nuts and bolts of your artistic history. This might include your education, where you were raised, formal or informal training, roles on relevant projects, etc. It is NOT an artist statement.

Headshot

Say "cheese"! Our judges like being able to put a name to a face. Please refrain from heavily filtered images or group shots.

Resume/CV (optional)

Please include a creative resume or artist CV if applicable. This is encouraged for artists with more established bodies of work.

This section is NOT required and does NOT impact your score.

Video Artist Statement (optional)

What drives your creative work? This is a chance for our judges to better understand the "why" behind your artistic process. Introduce yourself to our team and tell us about what makes you tick. Upload via Vimeo, YouTube, Dropbox, Google Drive, etc. Please make sure sharing is ON and PUBLIC. This section is NOT required and does NOT impact your score.
